

1. 1459 CROWN CHARTER by James II in favour of Alexander de Dunbar of fifth part of lands of barony of Burmukty, Elgin, on resignation of same by Thomas Lask (SRO no 9)
2. 1498 SPECIAL RETOUR OF INQUEST in favour of James Dunbar of Cumnock, kt, as heir to his father, Alexander Dunbar of Westfeild, who died 2 months previously, in lands of Westfeild, Focabers, and Aldcasch, and fourth part of lands of Querelwod and Lungate in sheriffdom of Elgin. (SRO no 17)

1500 TACK by Robert, prior of Pluscardin, and convent of same in favour of James Dunbar of Cumnock, kt, in recompense for his activities on their behalf of twa coblis of Spey for his lifetime for annual payment of 10 merks Scots and 2 barrels of salmon. (SRO no 19)
