

1. CLAIM TO PITSLIGO TITLE; documents and genealogies.

1. Memoir for Mr Forbes of Pitsligo to the arbiters in the subscription twixt him and Aberdour, 1780.
2. Notes on Forbuses mentioned in charters from 1469 onwards.
3. Notes about sasines etc affecting the family of Pitsligo.
4. Notes about the tacks of Pitsligo.
5. Inventory of Mr Patrick Rose's papers - Pitsligo research.
6. "Brief memoir on the contents of the foregoing collections" - Pitsligo papers.

CLAIM TO PITSLIGO TITLE; Correspondence - 1824 - 1830

1. Account jottings against Sir Charles Forbes relative to Pitsligo title, 1824
2. Duncan Davidson, Aberdeen to Patrick Rose about Sir Charles Forbes's enquiries into the Pitsligo title some years previously, 8 April 1824
3. Patrick Rose to Duncan Davidson about work previously done in research for Sir Charles Forbes, and possible future research, 12 April 1824.

CLAIM TO PITSLIGO TITLE 1824-30 contd.

4. Duncan Davidson to Patrick Rose: Sir Charles Forbes wishes to engage Mr Rose in further research into the Pitsligo title, 1824
5. P Rose to Duncan Davidson, advocate, Aberdeen, about the situation in which the Pitsligo title stands and about a previous unsuccessful attempt to claim the title, 1824
6. Duncan Davidson to Patrick Rose: every particle of information must be gleaned, 1824
7. Copy letter: Patrick Rose to Duncan Davidson: He has not had time to make extracts from mss as yet, 1824
8. D. Davidson to P Rose arranging a meeting: P Rose's notes on back, 1824
9. Same to same returning some mss while retaining others for further study, 1824
10. Same to same asking for more information, with copy of Rose's reply regarding mss he intends to consult, 1824
11. Mr Cuming to P Rose enclosing some particulars ref the Pitsligo title; with Rose's notes on back, 1824.
12. D Davidson to P Rose: the Pitsligo affair; with scroll reply, 1824
13. Same to same asking for some mss to show Sir Charles Forbes, nd.
14. Scroll: P Rose to D Davidson about the recent service of Sir Charles Forbes as heir male to his Great Great Grandfather Wm Forbes of New; He has acquired some more old documents which may be relevant, 1830
15. D Davidson to P Rose: would he send the above documents to Sir Charles Rose. With scroll reply agreeing to send them. 1830
16. Same to same acknowledging receipt of a wooden box of papers ref Pitsligo, with scroll reply, 1830
17. Copy letter, P Rose to D. Davidson enclosing a plan + some printed papers, 1830
