

1. Charter by Thomas Sutherland, burghess of Elgyne, with consent of Cristian Duff, his spouse, and James, his heir, in favour of Marion, his daughter, of one rood of land in burgh of Elgin, 7 Nov 1470

2. Notarial instrument recording agreement between Mr Gavin de Dunbar, dean of Moray, and David Balfour de Caraldstoun, as procurators for William Sutherland and Cristian Sutherland about lands. 10 June 1494
