

1. Grant by Nicholl Wylyameson, burress of FORRES, in favour of his spouse, Meg Achynroth, of his two roods of land in said burgh, in life rent, 20 Jan 1438/9.

2. Certificate by Alexander Urchart of Burisghardis as bailie of FORES, recording resignation by Elizabeth URUALE of a rood of land in burgh of FORES and granting sasine of same to John RYCHAELE, 21 Oct 1481

3. Charter by James Stewart, burress of Elgyn, in favour of John INGRAM, of one and a half roods of land in burgh of FORES, 22 June 1482,

4. Certificate by Archibald Brown, baillie of Fores, recording resignation in his hands by Donald HANRESON, burress of Fores of various lands in the freedom + burgh of FORES, in which lands he infefted John HANRESON, brother's son of said Donald, 4 Aug 1484.
