Until 1918 the only Catholic College for Training of Teachers was at Dowanhill, in Glasgow. In 1918 the Sacred Heart Sisters opened, as a private enterprise, in Moray Place, Edinburgh, a combined hostel and college. The hostel was for Catholic students and the College for the training of female teachers.

In 1919 the Scottish Education Department granted the College official recognition. The old Edinburgh Hydropathic at Craiglockhart was purchased, and in 1920 it opened as the new hostel and Training College, replacing the Moray Place premises.

In 1920 the College was transferred to the National Committee for the Training of Teachers.
