

This section consists of returns made by individual missions to the administrative centre of the district, later archdiocese. Generally speaking these returns are made at the request of the bishop or his administrator, and give details of the mission. Early returns shed a lot of light on the state of religion in the mission; later returns are mainly confined to financial accounts.

Also included in this section are inventories of mission property, again generally made at the request of the bishop.

Finally, as many of the returns deal with finances of individual missions, it was deemed appropriate to include in this section forms completed by missions wishing permission from the bishop to borrow specific sums of money.

For the period up to 1900 most of the documents formed part of the original deposit which had been arranged and indexed in the 1920s. In order to maintain the completeness of this deposit a few items, not strictly mission returns, have been kept in this section and are listed at the end of the pre-1901 material.
