LOANS TO MISSIONS: This section can be divided into two parts.

Documents relating to the period 1900-22 were found arranged by mission station and not by date. From 1923 onwards they were found arranged alphabetically under each year. These two different arrangements have been adhered to. Most of the documents consist of official loans forms (printed) which come in two sections: one for the archbishop and one for the lender. Sometimes both sections are to be found; at other times only the section for the archbishop. Included also is some correspondence + a number of receipts which were found with the loans forms.
