

The following papers were received from the Archbishop's residence in Edinburgh, St Bennetts, in January 1991. They included a series of papal bulls relating to episcopal appointments. These bulls have been kept together.

The rest of the deposit consisted of odd items covering the years 1836 to 1982. Since the items were so disparate, and often very unlike any previous ED material it was decided to list them as a separate deposit in their entirety, and not to try to integrate them into earlier deposits.

This decision was influenced not only by the type of items involved but also by the knowledge that it is now sixty years since Maguire catalogued and removed from St Bennetts the early ED material.
